The 27 individuals attending (shown at left) who had served in the U.S. Military were recognized. Each received a picture of the new memorial in front of the Arsenal that carries the inscription, "In honor of all Arsenal Technical

High School Alumni who have served our country in the United States Military."

The popular memorabilia table included a poster highlighting the special gifts made by former Tech history teacher, **Miss Helen Elliott**. She gave her historic 1867 home to Historic New Harmony to serve as their offices, and as a place "to educate visitors about the historic preservation in New Harmony." She and her sister gave the Elliott farm on the Wabash River to the State of Indiana as the basis of the Harmony State Park.

Professional entertainment was provided by 1946 graduate **Bob Finsterwald** of Athens, Ohio. His great renditions of the "Songs of the '40s and '50s" brought back a lot of great memories.

Thanks to the many generous contributions by our attendees and other class members, a check for \$812.93 was sent to the Tech Alumni Association.


