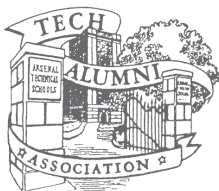

A Message from the Alumni Association President

Greetings Techites!

I cannot begin to put into words how much I personally appreciate those of you who have maintained support for Tech. In the past couple of years Tech has experienced several challenges. School administrators came and went as well as many faculty and staff. With the closing of three IPS high schools in the fall of last year, we witnessed many students re-assigned to Tech. This was made even more challenging because many of these students were starting their senior year. To complicate matters further, Tech received a new principal only a few weeks before the start of the school year. I remember visiting Tech while students picked up their first semester class schedules. I walked around speaking to several students and parents in the cafeteria. Most of them were overwhelmed with the vast size of the campus and so many buildings to become familiar with.

Under the leadership of Principal Franklin, a plan was developed and put into place to not only welcome new students and families to Tech, but also to inspire them to accept and support their new school. I visited Tech many times during the school year, to witness firsthand this transformation. One of the most effective tools used to reach this goal, was the entire staff and faculty working as a team.

Throughout the day, staff could be found engaging with students all around campus, from the moment students arrived to being present during each passing bell. Quickly, faculty and students began to establish and build positive relationships, with teachers reaching out to offer help and support whenever needed during the school year. At the end of the year I attended the graduation ceremony as one of the guest speakers. While students were preparing to line up, I spent time speaking with several seniors. Over a dozen were among the new students transferred to Tech that year as seniors. I posed this question to each one of them, "While at Tech did you have a good experience?". Each one of them responded the same, "it was a great year", and each seem to be very proud to be a Tech Titan.

Again, this year I visited Tech during first semester class schedule pick up. What a difference a year can make, as students understood the process for not only picking up their schedules, but also where to go to make any class changes. I could not help but notice how many grandparents were accompanying students while their parents were at work.

Our alumni also continue to grow in several ways, making constant changes towards improving how we operate and serve our membership, faculty and students at Tech. As one of our nation's largest alumni associations, we are challenged with the role as "torchbearer". As with any association, we are only as strong as the number of people who volunteer to serve. Alumni Association awarded an honorary Tech diploma to J. David (Dave) Arnold. Dave has taught art at various grade levels for thirty-five (35) years, twenty-eight (28) of those in IPS. Dave had been in charge of the Anderson Auditorium and the technical director since 2004. As a result, he provided the Alumni Association technical support for Alumni Day activities for the past several years. Dave retired from teaching at Tech in June of 2018. Tech Principal Corye Franklin presented Dave Arnold with his honorary diploma.

The **Karl Stipher Award** is given annually to recognize people, whether they are a graduate of Tech or not, who have dedicated themselves to Arsenal Technical High School. Recipients have had a positive influence on Tech in many aspects, worked with students, or made contributions in several other areas. The 2019 winner is John P. Gore Sr. John, a graduate of Crispus Attucks High School, is the father of three children – all Tech High School Alumni. John began volunteering at Tech when his children were students at Tech. When his oldest son returned to Tech to coach football and track, John worked with the head football coach starting the tradition of presenting a flower to each parent or guardian of each senior athlete on Senior Night. He has continued to assist with helping to present awards to athletes at the end of their season. Since 1999 he has coached golf, assisted the football coaches, run the concession stand, and managed the equipment room. He also

worked in the athletic director's office and for a while was the assistant to the athletic director. While coaching golf, two of his teams won Indianapolis Public School Athletic Conference Championships and he was named "Coach of the Year". John continues to be dedicated to doing whatever was needed to make the Tech Athletic Department look good and be the best in IPS.

For the first time the **Wally Potter Memorial Award** went to both a female and male athlete. The Alumni Association hopes to make this an on-going tradition.

Our first Wally Potter honoree was Sherrie Dawson ('90). By the end of her senior year for her excellence in basketball, Sherrie had been selected as a member of the Indianapolis All-City team, Indiana All-State team, First Team All-American, as well as the Indianapolis Star All-Star team to name only a few of her high school accomplishments. Sherrie served as a team captain, leading the girl's team to a city championship and two sectional championships. After high school she went on to attend Northeastern Oklahoma A&M College in Miami, OK.

The second Wally Potter honoree was Dwayne Anthony Enaram ('76). Follow-

ing in his two older brothers (Hosea ('72) and Dannie ('73)) footsteps, Dwayne joined Tech's wrestling team. Although Dwayne participated in freshman football, wrestling was his sport. In his weight class, his freshman year he was freshman Wrestling Champ. His junior year he won the City Championship (MVP), Sectional Championship, and Regional Championship as well as being the Semi-State Runner-Up. His senior year (1976) he won the City Championship (MVP), Sectional Championship, Regional Championship, Semi-State Championship, and State Championship finishing with a record of 32-0. That year he was also named a high-school All-American. While active in wrestling, he was also a member of the Tech Legion, the winner of the Barton Bradley Scholarship, and Vice-President of the Class of 1976. Dwayne gives credit to Coach John Hurrele and his assistant coaches for teaching life long skills while also teaching the sport.

The **2019 Duane Blankenhorn Award** went to William R. (Bill) Buckley ('69). As a Tech student he participated in speech team, service club, the Student Affairs Organization (SAO) Executive Board, German Club and Techoir. He also was a captain in the Tech Legion. Bill retired from Indianapolis Public Schools after 39 years of service – having been a teacher, department head and vice-principal at several schools (including Tech). Bill has served on the Executive Board of the Alumni Association for over fifteen (15) years and is currently the Immediate Past-President.
