resident Anita Matthews has selected David Best ('46) as the 2021 President's Award recipient. A 1950 Harvard graduate, David then served in the US Air Force from 1950 - 1953. Returning from the service he joined his father where he was vice president of Henry L. Best & Son, Inc., a civil engineering and land surveying firm. From 1971 to 1999 he was vice president of BDA Corporation, an architectural and engineering firm. From 1999 to 2008 Mr. Best was the land surveyor in residence for the Dominion Group, a commercial real estate development firm. From 1981 to 1999 he was an instructor at IUPUI in the land surveying curriculum. His professional memberships include the Indiana Society of Professional Land Surveyors, United States Professional Land Surveyors, and the American Congress of Surveying and Mapping. He is the author of numerous professional articles and has travelled the world, sharing his expertise in surveying and mapping. Mr. Best

has also been active as a professional public speaker on a variety of subjects; this includes performing reenactments as George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, and the Marauis de Lafayette. David was a 1996 recipient of the Alumni Association's Hanson H. Anderson Award. He has been an active Tech High School alum, chairing the 50th, 60th and 70th year reunions for the Class

of 1946. Other organizations to which David belongs include Toastmasters International, the Breakfast Optimist Club, and the Harvard Club of Indiana. He is a member and Elder of Fairview Presbyterian Church of Indianapolis.

at Arlington High School, receiving extensive training on IEP's (Individual Educational Plans) and other types of special needs reporting. As she gained knowledge and experience, she eventually became the Registrar for Arlington. When Arlington left the IPS system, Melody found herself looking for a new school. Fate brought her to the registrar position at Arsenal Technical High School. She found Tech to be an amazing school - with so much history, a beautiful campus, and a group of truly loyal current and former students and staff. She received encouragement and support from Dr. Vernita Robinson, who at that time was the Director of Guidance. Dr. Robinson helped Melody understand the critical importance of the registrar position. Working with Dr. Robinson was a great adventure and contributed to Melody's enjoyment of her time at Tech. Melody's days are filled with interactions with Tech students. In addition to ensuring today's Titans have accurate academic records, she spends time encouraging them to do their best and to accomplish all they can during their time at Tech. She also provides invaluable assistance to former Tech students by furnishing them with their school records. She has helped the Alumni Association on numerous occasions by providing them with historical information about the school and its graduates.

The **Karl J. Stipher Award** is given to a person who has dedicated themselves in some way to Arsenal Technical High School. **Ms. Judy Driver** has been a culinary specialist for IPS for sixteen years. In this capacity she gives hands-on training to students at the Colonel's Cupboard, the model restaurant located on the Tech campus. Her students not only learn how to prepare delicious cuisine, but they learn how to set up and run the restaurant. The Colonel's Cupboard is open to the public and not only serves the faculty and staff at Tech, but patrons from all over Indianapolis. The Cupboard also caters events on the Tech campus and has been especially supportive of Tech Alumni Association events. Ms. Driver strives to give her students real world experience. When her students exit the program, they are prepared to work in food service or to continue their studies in the culinary arts. In addition to her service with IPS, she has worked at the Indianapolis Airport Authority in Minority and Women Owned Business Development. Her volunteer activities include working as the Employment Committee Chair at the Indianapolis Urban League and as the VIP Chair (University Presidents Host) at the Circle City Classic.

The Alumni Board has chosen Jenny Goodnight Yarian-Scalpelli ('64) as this year's Duane Blankenhorn Memorial Award recipient. At Tech Jenny was a 4-year band member, on yearbook staff, in Techoir and Tech Legion. She served as corresponding secretary of both the XYZ (math) Club and the cheer block. In 1968 Jenny earned a B.S. degree in mathematics from Bethany College (WV) returning to Tech to teach math during 1968-69 school year. From 1970 until 2011 she worked for the State of Indiana, first in the Department of Workforce Development and later in the Office of Technology. She worked as a mainframe programmer, analyst, trainer and technical support person for software and hardware. For over forty years she was actively involved in what is now known as the International Association of Workforce Professionals, serving in local and national positions. As Director of Communications for the Tech Alumni Association, Jenny is the editor of Technically Speaking, the Alumni newsletter. She is actively involved in maintaining the Tech Alumni membership information, in finding veterans names for the Veterans Memorial, and in sharing Alumni Association information on social media.

Isadore Cosby ('81) is this year's Wally Potter Memorial Award Winner. Isadore, at the age of six, attended an awards ceremony with his mother honoring one of his brothers, fueling his desire to attend Tech High School. He wanted to follow in the footsteps of his father who owned a Heating and Air Conditioning Business. Despite living in the Manual High School district, he was able to attend Tech for the technological programs offered in the Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) field. During his junior year (1979-80), because of his HVAC studies, Isadore was accepted into the Industrial Cooperation Training (ICT) program. At that time, Tech offered apprentice programs where students could work while attending school. Eli Lilly and Company recruited Isadore as an apprentice in HVAC. After graduation in 1983, he began his HVAC career at Eli Lilly, retiring after 37 years. During his time at Lilly, he earned associate degree from Ivy Tech in HVAC. Isadore was an accomplished athlete. In the 1977-78 season, he won the City Freshman Wrestling Championship in the 126-pound weight division. He also was a member of the reserve wrestling team that year. He was a member of varsity wrestling teams in 1978-79, 1979-80, and 1980-81 seasons. The 1979-80 team won the Wresting State Championship. Isadore was a member of the freshman and reserve football teams in 1977, reserve and varsity football teams in 1978, and the varsity football team in 1979 and 1980. He served as a volunteer assistant wrestling coach at Tech for two seasons. Isadore is a dedicated supporter of the Tech Alumni Association and is a current member of both the Alumni Day and Ways and Means Committees.
