

Norman Terry ('61) Named 2011 Alumnus of the Year

The Arsenal Technical High School Alumni Association is pleased to announce that Norman Terry has been named the 2011 Alumnus of the Year. He is a 1961 graduate of Tech.

While a student, he participated in football and track. After graduating from Tech, Norman attended the University of Indianapolis where he earned a Bachelor of Art in 1965. He then earned a Master of Art from Indiana University in 1967. He also was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Indianapolis in 1998. Norman continues his connection to Tech through the Earl Terry Scholarship for Tech students.


Norman's career began with Burger Chef Systems as Director of Marketing for the Sani Serv affiliate, then national sales manager for McQuay-Perfex. He was Vice President of Marketing for WelBilt Corporation from 1982 to 1986 and then president of a multi-company group with ALCO Standard Foodservice from 1986 until 1990. In 1991 he purchased Prince Castle, Inc., and lead the company to world-class performance levels. After selling the company in 1998, he continued to lead the company until 2001.

Through his work, Norman was a member of the National Association of Equipment Manufacturers, the National Restaurant Association, and the Society for Food Management. He has also served on the advisory board for Ronald McDonald's Children's Charities and has been a UINDY Trustee since 1997. Norman has been awarded the Illinois Governor's Award for Export Excellence and the U. S. Department of Commerce President's Export Excellence Award.

Norman has been married to his wife, Dottie, since 1965. They have two sons and three grandchildren. Norman enjoys reading, music, travel, playing bridge, international studies and consulting.

Norman has shared that he was blessed to have attended Tech during his formative years. He will be forever appreciative of the excellent education that he received, which prepared him for life and the competitive endeavors in which he engaged.

Duane Blankenhorn Award • Ronald Jackson

Ron, class of 1953, was active in student organizations while at Tech. He was a homeroom president, president of the Senior Council, captain in the Tech Legion, Senior Class president and prom committee leader. Ron participated in athletics as a basketball player for three years and a football player for four years. Additionally, he was captain and quarterback for the varsity football team.

Ron's support of ATHS has continued after graduation. He has led the Tech Guys and Tech Gals group for the past 10 years. He is on the ATHS Athletic Hall of Fame committee, and a Tech scholarship provider. He has served as President, Vice President, and Treasurer of the ATHS Alumni Executive Board. Most importantly, Ron organized the "Howard Longshore Stadium" and "Wally Potter Field" naming and permanent signage program.

In 1961, Ron started his own art studio, the Jackson-Zender Studios in the First Federal Building downtown. In 1973, he was able to design and build his own building on Southeastern Avenue. He later expanded by adding a printing company. He then founded the Jackson Group which included a mailing and fulfillment company, an exhibit and display company, and a telemarketing company. Ron retired when he sold the Jackson Group in December, 2010.

Ron's hobbies and special interests include photography, home movies, sports, traveling, fishing, big band music, jazz, live theatre, old cars, and Bible studies. Ron is married to Katherine. They have two daughters, five grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

Duane Blankenhorn Award • Betty Brock Stucker

Betty graduated from Tech High School in 1950. While at Tech, she participated in summer school band and ROTC Honorary Captain. Betty attended IU Extension and Indiana Central after graduating from Tech.

In the 1960's, Betty returned to Tech to work with Jack Bradford, Athletic Director. She also worked at Southport High School and the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. She also spent over 20 years as a realtor.

Betty has served on the Board of the American Cancer Society, the National Association of Realtors, the Metropolitan Indianapolis Board of Realtors and her Church Board. She received Community Service recognition from Mayors Lugar and Hudnut.

Betty has served on the ATHS Alumni Board for many years as Reunion Coordinator, Alumni Day Activities Coordinator and on the Nomination and Award Selection Committee. She received the Hanson H. Anderson Award from the Alumni Association in 2004.

Betty was married to Bob Stucker(Class of '49) from 1952 until his death in 1995. They lived in California while he was in the Navy during the Korean War. They have three children, seven grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.

Karl J. Stipher Award • J. Jerry Whitaker

J. Jerry Whitaker graduated from Tech High School in 1956. While at Tech he played baseball, basketball and golf. From 1956 until 1962, Jerry served the US Marine Corps and the US Air Force, where he served in Vietnam. He attended one year at the University of Maryland in England while in the Air Force. He also attended numerous schools while working in the fire service.

From 1965 to 1986, he worked for the Indianapolis Fire Department, retiring as a division chief. He was the Safety Director for Market Square Arena, from 1986 to 1989. He finished his career as the Lawrence Township Fire Department Chief from 1989 to 1998.

Through his work in the fire safety world, Jerry received several awards, including Fireman of the Year for Valor and the Red Cross Hall of Fame Valor Award. January 17, 1986 was declared J. Jerry Whitaker Day by Mayor Hudnut. He also was named a Sagamore of the Wabash in 1998.

Jerry has been married to his wife, Sandra, for 52 years. They have three children, eight grandchildren, and one great grandchild.

Wally Potter Award • Felson Bowman

Felson Bowman graduated from Tech High School in 1958. While a student at Tech, Felson participated in football, track and wrestling. He lettered in football, played on the 1958 undefeated football team and served as its co-captain. Upon graduation, Felson attended Northwestern University (Evanston, IL) and Butler University (Indianapolis). He graduated from Butler University with a Bachelor of Science Degree and from Indiana University School of Law with a Doctor of Jurisprudence Degree.

From 1961-1968, Felson was employed by The Marion County Sheriff's Office and rose to the rank of Captain. Since that time he has practiced law with Lewis, Bowman, St. Clair & Wagner. He also formed Solar Sources, Inc., an Indiana coal mining company and largest privately owned coal-mining company in the State of Indiana, in 1974. He has served and continues to serve as the President and Chairman of the Board for Solar Sources.

Felson was admitted to practice law in Indiana, the Federal Court, Southern District of Indiana, The United States 7th Circuit Court of Appeals and The Supreme Court of The United States. He has appeared in briefs to The United States Supreme Court and is a member of the Indianapolis and Indiana Bar Associations. Felson has been appointed twice by the Governor of Indiana to serve on Energy Policy and Coal Mining Advisory Boards.

Felson attends Mount Pleasant Christian Church. He also continues his interest in Tech High School athletics and has participated in fundraising activities for Tech High School. He is an avid yet no-so-good golfer and plays golf whenever he can. He is also interested in hunting and fishing and has hunted big game in Africa on many occasions.

Felson has been married to Jane Ellen Brock-Jones, a 1961 Tech H.S. Graduate, for 44 years. They have two children and six grandchildren.

Honorary Tech Graduate • Kandis Brown

Kandis Brown has taught at Tech for 26 years. She is a vocal music and keyboarding teacher and also works with the Techniques, Techromatics, Techoir, the male and female barbershop choruses and quartets. Kandis also produces the yearly Madrigal Dinner and assists with the all-city and all-state choirs. She is lovingly called the "flower lady" at all of the school musicals.

Kandis earned her Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the University of Indianapolis and her Master's of Music Education from Butler University. In 2003, Kandis was the AHS Teacher of the Year and received the ABCD Award from IPS. She has also received the Prelude Outstanding Art Educator Award in 2000, the Educator Award from Harmony Festival Camp in 2010, and the Educator Award from Cardinal District Harmony Society in 2009.

Kandis loves to travel as witnessed by the fact she has been to 16 countries and 41 states. She has been to the bottom of the Grand Canyon and the top of the Alps, climbed the Sydney Bridge and driven the Alaskan Highway. She also loves to read, knit and crochet, and is working on her genealogy.
