2018 Alumnus of the Year Linda Ingle Haas, class of 1968

Linda Ingle Haas graduated from Tech in 1968, with business and academic concentrations. While at Tech, she played violin in the orchestra and worked on the Arsenal Cannon. She took an Introduction to Sociology course, which became an inspiration for future study. In 1969, she married her high school sweetheart, Ain Haas (1968 valedictorian and class president). Thanks to scholarships, including those provided by Tech, she attended and graduated from IU-Bloomington in 1972, majoring in sociology. During college, she developed and worked in recreational programs for children, in her old neighborhood, Brightwood. She was awarded a full scholarship to graduate school at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, receiving a master's degree in sociology in 1973 and the PhD in 1977.

In 1977, Linda accepted a position as Assistant Professor of Sociology on the growing IUPUI campus, and was promoted to full Professor by 1993. While at IUPUI, Linda helped to found the Women's Studies Program and developed new courses in gender studies. She won numerous teaching awards, including the highest awarded by the IU system, the President's Award for Excellence in Teaching. She was a pioneer in service learning and a founding faculty member of University College, the gateway for incoming students. For service to students, she won the campus' highest mentoring award, the Bynum Award in 2004. While at IUPUI, Linda actively served the community, not only in volunteering alongside her students, but also serving various agencies, especially those serving girls and young women, including Big Sisters. In 1993 she received the Selby Award for Leadership in Services to Girls and Young Women in Central Indiana.

In retirement, she continues her research and professional service activities. In 2018, she has worked in Australia on a project concerning work flexibility in the construction industry and in Sweden on a research project on companies' accommodation of fathers taking parent leave. With Ain, she maintains a heavy travel schedule, involving research, visits to friends and relatives and vacations (often to snorkel the world's diminishing reefs). When home, she volunteers for Keep Indianapolis Beautiful, the Indiana Native Plant and Wildflower Society and the Meridian Kessler Neighborhood Association. When there's time, she enjoys working in the garden.

Ain and Linda have two daughters, both graduates of IPS schools. Vaike is a professor in landscape architecture at West Virginia University. Leili is a shelter veterinarian in Orlando, Florida. Linda and Ain have one grandson, Kyrian.


